Stumbling blocks of engineering teams working in silos

Simulation-related activities are still managed by a few domain experts.

This siloed approach to product development is the cause of costly inefficiencies and delays.

Typical problems include:

• No real-time collaboration across departments

Many engineering teams still share simulation data (e.g. CAD geometries, CAE models, simulation workflows, reports) via worksheets, email, or shared drives with no version control. Tracing results back to a particular model can include manual interactions, increasing the throughput time.

Undefined engineering design processes

Traditional project management tools make it difficult to trace and reproduce engineering design processes. Tracing where a request for simulation came from, who is in charge of preparing a CAD or performing CAE analysis, and where to access the latest version of this data can be redundantly complex.

• Fragmented access caused by a myriad of vendor-locked tools



VOLTA empowers collaboration across engineering teams, allowing you to safely capture, version and share data in a server-based environment.


With VOLTA APIs, insights from simulation are accessible to stakeholders across the enterprise (e.g. CAD designers, suppliers).




3. Explore and Optimize

They can run design space exploration strategies and leverage ESTECO optimization algorithms to find the optimal design.


Finally, VOLTA job scheduling maximizes the use of IT resources by distributing computational workloads across HPC and cloud environments.




4. Analyze and Visualize


